



2020-21 was very much a year of connection, teamwork and achievement at VTRA. Our Therapeutic Riding Program and Stable Management Program continued to thrive as our core programming. With a few adjustments to ensure the safety of our participants, volunteers, and staff, we were able to continue to ride the waves of the second year of the pandemic.

We are incredibly proud of all the new ideas, new faces and new programming that has occurred over this past year at VTRA.

It was important to us to invite new partnerships in and host different demographic of participants in order to support our community, while keeping our programs thriving.

In 2021, we expanded our Exercise Rider Program in partnership with Full Spectrum Equestrian, who also were on site for eight months, accessing VTRA's facility while their Owner and Coach, Liesl Fulton, was able to facilitate and elevate our Exercise Rider Program. The 2021 program continued to operate at almost maximum capacity. VTRA core programs were well-attended as the Adaptive Riding, Stable Management, and Adaptive Driving program saw plenty of participants, learning and success!



48 participants worked on progressive skills, 53 worked on physical movement & mobility, 37 joined us early riders, and 84 focused on recreation & social skills



#### **FUNDING AND ADVANCEMENT**

VTRA continues to explore and work to secure a variety of funding sources to support program development, delivery, operations, herd care and facility upkeep and maintenance.

2021 saw continued support from a number of granting bodies, service clubs and generous donors. VTRA was especially fortunate to receive support from a number of organizations interested in VTRA's unique equine-focused programs.

Core programs continued to generate revenue through the collection of program fees. Participants are asked to pay program fees in conjunction with other community funding schemes to support program costs. VTRA also receives donor directed funds aimed at supporting participants through its own bursary program annually. 3 participants accessed the VTRA Bursary Program in 2021.




#### THANK YOU TO OUR 2021 SUPPORTERS!
