- Mask use is now a personal choice for most indoor public spaces in British
 Columbia. Some businesses and workplaces may choose to require masks on
 their premises to support certain people or populations that may be at a higher
 risk.
- As of March 11, 2022, VTRA will no longer require the use of masks in the barn or clubhouse, but will continue supporting participants, volunteers, staff and/or guests who choose to continue wearing a mask when on site.
